The chapter annually conducts two Teacher Workshops. To better serve the western-most county of the four counties the chapter conducts a workshop in Pensacola. Our last two have been held at the National Flight Academy next to the National Naval Aviation Museum. These have been very successful events with over 50+ teachers in attendance. All workshops include tours of flight facilities, simulator flights, actual flights for two selected teachers on CAP aircraft, flight line static displays, and in the afternoon we conduct multiple breakout workshops building rockets, robots, airplanes, hot air balloons, and many other science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) oriented activities. These workshops cost the chapter approximately \$3,000.00 each.

Another major event for the chapter is the annual Teacher Awards Banquet. This banquet is to recognize our Elementary, Middle, and High School Teacher of the year. The event is normally attended by teachers competing for the awards, their school's principal, family and friends, County School Superintendents, Congressman Jeff Miller or his representative, The AFSOC Commander, 1 SOW Commander and other Hurlburt Field Group Commanders, Community Business Partners, and Chapter members. Each winning teacher is presented with a certificate, a check for \$250, the school principals of the winners are presented with a US Flag flown over the Capital, and the overall winner's school principal is presented with an additional check of \$250. The dinner for the winning teachers, a guest, and their Principal is paid for by the chapter. We would like to expand that program to make it free to all teachers that competed for the Teacher of the Year and their school principal. This event also costs the chapter approximately \$3,000.00.

Other annual programs include:

- \$400 Grants to 7-10 Hurlburt Airman completing the Associates degree approx. \$3,000.00
- quarterly and Annual Awards to 505 CCW and Annual Awards to Team Hurlburt's outstanding Airman and the AFSOC Outstanding Airmen of the year. approx. \$2,400.00
- "Unsung Hero" Luncheon for 20 Airman each year approx. \$700.00
- East Panhandle Science Fair with four awards in the senior and junior divisions \$350.00
- AFROTC, AFJROTC, and CAP Scholarship and Drill Meet support approx. \$3,000.00
- Send one teacher a year to Space Camp approx. \$1,000.
- Support local High Schools in sponsoring teams to participate in CyberPatriot (A worldwide Cyber Defense Competitions)
- Support teams for FIRST Lego League, a robotics program for 9 to 16 year olds designed to get children excited about science and technology -- and teach them valuable employment and life skills.
